ORDINANCE NO. 1201

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 15-504 AND 15-505 OF THE HORTON MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING RESIDENTIAL CONTAINERS USED FOR COLLECTING SOLID WASTE IN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HORTON, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HORTON, KANSAS:

Section 1. Section 15-504 of the Horton Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

“15-504. DUTY OF OWNER, OCCUPANT. The owner or occupant of every dwelling unit or commercial enterprise shall use a container provided by the City for the storage of solid waste as provided in this article. No owner or occupant shall permit to accumulate quantities of refuse or other waste materials within or close to any structure within the city unless the same is stored in the city-provided container and in such a manner as not to create a health or fire hazard.”

Section 2. Section 15-505 of the Horton Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

“15-505. CONTAINERS. Residential customers shall use a container provided by the City or their designee that shall have a capacity of not more than 96 gallons. They shall be of galvanized metal or other non-rusting material of substantial construction. Each container shall have a tight-fitting lid and shall be leak-proof and fly tight. All containers shall have handles of suitable construction to permit lifting. All garbage shall be drained of all liquids before being placed in containers.”

Section 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
