ORDINANCE NO. 1094

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 15-204(g) OF THE HORTON MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING THE FORMULA FOR COMPUTING THE ENERGY COST ADJUSTMENT FEE ASSESSED BY THE CITY OF HORTON, KANSAS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HORTON, KANSAS:

Section 1. Section 15-204(g) of the Horton Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

“15-204. RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL FEES AND RATES

The following fees and rates shall be available to consumers for residential use and to consumers for commercial use:

(g) Energy Cost Adjustment The Energy Cost Adjustment is a direct pass through of the City’s entire cost of providing power to meet the City’s energy requirements. The ECA will be calculated as follows.

The City will collect all costs of the city’s wholesale power supply, the city’s transmission charges, any city generation, and any other associated costs of delivering the City’s energy supply. The City will then divide the total cost of their energy charges with the total metered energy delivered to the City to develop a monthly average cost per kWh. The City of Horton shall then divide the monthly average cost per kWh by 1.15 for the city losses (City generation and purchases/City billed) to determine each month’s Total Cost of Power. The Base Rate (\$0.04/kWh) will be subtracted from the Total Cost of Power to determine the monthly ECA. The ECA will then be multiplied with each customer’s monthly kWh consumption to complete the Retail Rates for the City of Horton electric customers.

$$\frac{\text{Total Energy Charges (\$)}}{\text{Total Metered Energy (kWh)/1.15}} = \text{Total \$/kWh} - \$0.04/\text{kWh} = \text{ECA}$$

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
