ORDINANCE NO. 1098

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 15-204(a) and (b) OF THE HORTON MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING THE RATES CHARGED TO CONSUMERS FOR RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL USE BY THE CITY OF HORTON, KANSAS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HORTON, KANSAS:

Section 1. Section 15-204(a) and (b) of the Horton Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

“15-204. RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL FEES AND RATES

The following fees and rates shall be applicable to consumers for residential and commercial use:

(a) Residential Consumer Rate

1. Eligibility for the Residential electric rate is limited to dwelling units supplied through one (1) meter for domestic use. This rate is not applicable to dwelling units used for commercial purposes; however, if the customer’s wiring is so arranged that electric service for domestic and non-domestic purposes can be metered separately, then this rate is applicable to that portion used for domestic purposes.

2. Service Charge - \$8.00 for service located within the City Limits and \$14.00 for service located outside of the City Limits

Kilowatt Hour Charge - \$.095 per kilowatt hour for service located within the City Limits and \$.105 per kilowatt hour for service located outside of the City Limits.

(b) Regular Commercial Rate

1. Eligibility for the Regular Commercial electric rate is limited to non-dwelling units or dwelling units used for commercial purposes for which the demand for each calendar year is less than 250,000 kilowatt hours based on the previous calendar year’s usage; however, if the customer’s wiring is so arranged that electric service for domestic and non-domestic purposes can be metered

separately, then this rate is applicable to that qualifying portion used for non-domestic purposes only.

2. Service Charge - \$8.00 for service located within the City Limits and \$14.00 for service located outside of the city limits

Kilowatt Hour Charge - \$.090 per kilowatt hour for service located within the City Limits and \$.100 per kilowatt hour for service located outside of the City Limits.

(c) Large User Commercial Rate

1. Eligibility for the Large User Commercial electric rate is limited to non-dwelling units or dwelling units used for commercial purposes for which the demand for each calendar year is more than 250,000 kilowatt hours based on the previous calendar year's usage; however, if the customer's wiring is so arranged that electric service for domestic and non-domestic purposes can be metered separately, then this rate is applicable to that qualifying portion used for non-domestic purposes only.

2. Service Charge - \$50.00 for service located within the City Limits and \$65.00 for service located outside of the city limits

Kilowatt Hour Charge - \$.085 per kilowatt hour for service located within the City Limits and \$.095 per kilowatt hour for service located outside of the City Limits.

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
