ORDINANCE NO. 1115

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1-310 OF THE HORTON MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF CITY ADMINISTRATOR AND AMENDING SECTION 1-209 PERTAINING TO THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF MAYOR OF THE CITY OF HORTON, KANSAS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HORTON, KANSAS:

Section 1. Section 1-310 of the Horton Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

- “1-310. CITY ADMINISTRATOR; POWERS AND DUTIES. (a) To devote all necessary time and attention to the affairs of the city and be responsible to the governing body for the efficient administration of its affairs.
- (b) To attend all meetings of the governing body with the right to take part in the discussion, but having no vote.
- (c) To see that all terms and conditions imposed in favor of the city are faithfully kept and performed and upon knowledge of any violation thereto, to call the same to the attention of the governing body.
- (d) To work with the City Clerk in preparing and recommending to the governing body, prior to the beginning of each fiscal year, a budget for the ensuing fiscal year, showing in as much detail as practicable, the estimated amounts of revenues and expenditures for the efficient operation of the city government.
- (e) To recommend to the governing body such measures as he or she may deem necessary or expedient.
- (f) To do and perform such other duties as may be prescribed by ordinance or resolution of the governing body.”

Section 2. Section 1-209 of the Horton Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

- “1-209. MAYOR; POWERS AND DUTIES.
- (a) The mayor shall preside at all meetings of the board of commissioners, except as otherwise provided by statute.
- (b) The mayor shall work with State agencies, engineers, contractors and other third parties in coordinating current and future projects as a representative of the City.
- (c) The mayor shall assist with the recruiting of new businesses to the City of Horton to aid economic development and help existing businesses maintain their businesses or expand the same as a representative of the City.

- (d) The mayor may attend relevant workshops and meetings to gain knowledge on programs available to the City of Horton, Kansas.
- (e) The mayor shall perform such other duties as may be agreed by the governing body that are not incompatible with the office of mayor.”

Section 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
